

Official Rules

Cooking:

- Chili may contain any ingredients.
- Each team must bring their own ingredients & supplies needed to prepare.
- Electricity may or may not be available, so come prepared. Cooking on grills, portable burners, etc. is required.
- All ingredients must be cooked and added on site after check-in.
- You MAY pre-chop vegetables and other ingredients etc.

Set Up:

- The Chamber will supply each team with a 10x10 space.
- Bring your own “space” including grills, tents, chairs, heaters, etc.
- Bring bottle of hand sanitizer
- Set up is Saturday morning March 20, 2021 from 8am till 9am.
- There will be a cook’s meeting at 9am on the day of the cook-off. One member of each team MUST attend. You will be given your judging cup for each entry. Each team is responsible for delivering their cups to the judging area no later than noon.

Misc:

- You must pre-register for the event. Walk-ups are not permitted and will not be judged.
- Be prepared to serve a minimum of 3 gallons of chili to your adoring fans.
- Cost per team: \$25.00-Checks can be made out to Whitesboro Chamber of Commerce or cash will be accepted.
- The public can buy tickets for \$1.00 per sample of chili beginning at 12:15 and ending at 1pm or until chili is gone.
- No offensive displays, excessive noise or music will be permitted.
- Everything must be prepared in a sanitary manner.
- Hats, gloves & masks must be worn when handling, cooking & serving.
- Chili or fixings must be covered when not being used.

Judging:

- 1st place \$250, 2nd place \$200 and 3rd place \$150. Judge’s decision is FINAL.
- Special award for entry with most tickets
